EMPLOYABILITY CURRICULUM

FHS FRESHMEN AND SOPHOMORES

In addition to attending the FHS Club Fair this week, FHS freshmen and sophomores were introduced to why emotional relation and emotional intelligence are important to employability skills and being successful in the classroom. Parent/guardian sample follow-up questions:

- What emotion is the hardest for you to control?
- What emotion do you think is most important in the workplace? School? Why?

FHS JUNIORS

Juniors explored the Naviance Resume log to use to document activities for future employment or college applications. Juniors also reviewed the progress of goals previously created. Students identified possible future career interests. Parent /guardian sample follow-up questions:

- What is Naviance?
- Why is it important to track activities/interests/honors?
- What is one new thing that you learned about the employment process?
- Have you been successful in working toward your goals?
- What actions are you taking to work toward your future identify/career path?

FHS SENIORS

Seniors utilized Naviance to create a vision for their senior year and beyond. Seniors also explored effective communication strategies and email etiquette. Parent/guardian sample follow-up questions:

- Ask your student what resources they can use to work toward their vision and goals?
- How does email etiquette differ from text?

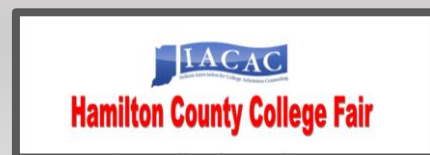
