FHS OFFERS SAT PREP CLASS

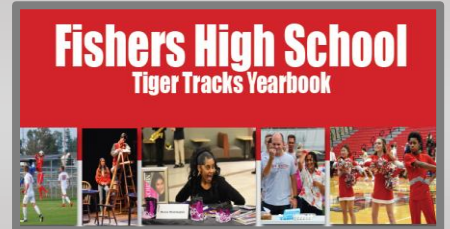
FHS is offering an SAT prep class in September to prepare students for the October and November SAT tests. Click [HERE](#) to access the registration form.
