- Community Service hours are to be documented on the Senior Community Service Hours Form available in the Guidance Office. Completed forms need to be turned into the Guidance Office by May 1st.
- Hours performed for other school service organizations (such as National Honor Society, Student Council, Key Club and Students in Action) **will count** toward Senior Community Service hours. Those hours also need to be documented on the Senior Community Service Hours form and turned into Guidance.
