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FISHERS HIGH SCHOOL OVERVIEW

Fishers High School is a comprehensive four year high school serving over 3600 students enrolled in grades 9 through 12. Fishers High School is accredited by the Indiana Department of Education. Fishers High School is also a member of The College Board.

Fishers High School has recently been named one of the top high schools in the nation by Newsweek, U.S. News & World Report and the Washington Post.

Fishers High School, located in Fishers, Indiana, a northeastern suburb of Indianapolis, is one of two high schools in the Hamilton Southeastern School District, the fastest growing school corporation in Indiana. The district is also comprised of four junior high schools, four intermediate schools and thirteen elementary schools.

CURRICULUM

The school year is divided into two semesters of eighteen weeks each. Credit earned per course varies depending on the course. The school day consists of four eighty-three minute periods and a thirty minute lunch period.

Fishers High School provides challenging academic opportunities including Honors, Advanced Placement, Advanced College Project (ACP), Dual College Credit, Project Lead the Way, Academy of Finance and the International Baccalaureate diploma. Over 90% of the graduates enroll in post-secondary programs.

Seniors who take a rigorous schedule, equivalent to a full semester of college credit, will be given the option of reducing their course load by 1-3 classes. During the flex periods, seniors will make choices about the use of discretionary time, but they will be required to maintain academic proficiency.

GPA/CLASS RANK

The cumulative GPA is computed from a 4.33 scale with grades of all courses utilized. All Honors, ACP, AP and IB courses are weighted, with AP courses receiving a heavier weight when calculating the GPA.
