HOW DO I GET COLLEGE CREDIT FOR AP SCORES?

- Each college/university has its own AP credit policy that can be found on the college website.
- Generally, if you score a 3,4, or 5 you can earn at least elective credit and often a 4 or 5 will earn you specific course credit.
- The credit awarded can vary from university to university and even within different programs at the same university. If you change your major/program while in college, make sure you work with an academic advisor to reevaluate your AP scores to make sure they give you every possible benefit.
- Often students meet with an academic advisor during their orientation process. Ask specific questions about AP credit – If your orientation is scheduled before the university receives your AP scores, you will want to follow up on this.



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- During the AP exam process, you could have selected the college that you would like to have receive your AP score report. Once scores are available, the score report should include all AP exams that you have taken. Occasionally, student's scores are not all on one report for a variety of reasons, so please follow up and check to make sure the university has all of your scores.
- If you did not previously request that your scores be sent to a university, you can do this through your College Board account at <https://apscore.collegeboard.org/scores/score-reporting> This site also has more information that can help answer a variety of questions.



HOW DO I GET COLLEGE CREDIT FOR IB SCORES?

- **IB students must let the IB coordinator know by May 21st, 2019 what college they want to have receive their scores – Fishers HS IB coordinator is Jennifer Gabbard**
- **Each college/university has its own IB credit policy that can be found on the college website.**
- **Generally, if you score a 4, you can earn at least elective credit and often a higher score will earn you specific course credit.**
- **The credit awarded can vary from university to university and even within different programs at the same university. If you change your major/program while in college, make sure you work with an academic advisor to reevaluate your IB scores to make sure they give you every possible benefit.**
- **Often students meet with an academic advisor during their orientation process. Ask specific questions about IB credit – if your orientation is scheduled before the university receives your IB scores, you will want to follow up on this.**

DUAL CREDIT FROM INDIANA UNIVERSITY - ACP

- If you registered for dual credit courses offered through Indiana University (ACP) –
 - And you are going to IU, grades will be submitted to IU at the end of the semester. IU will process the grade and then the course and grade should be on your IU transcript shortly after
 - If you are going to a different university, you must request your transcript from IU to be sent to your college of choice using the following link

DUAL CREDIT FROM BALL STATE UNIVERSITY

- If you registered for dual credit courses offered through Ball State University –
 - And you are going to Ball State, grades will be submitted to Ball State at the end of the semester. Ball State will process the grade and then the course and grade should be on your Ball State transcript shortly after
 - If you are going to a different university, you must request your transcript from Ball State be sent to the college of your choice using the following link

DUAL CREDIT FROM PURDUE POLYTECHNIC/ANDERSON

- If you registered for dual credit courses offered through Purdue Polytechnic/Anderson –
 - And you are going to PU, grades will be submitted to PU at the end of the semester. PU will process the grade and then the course and grade should be on your PU transcript shortly after
 - If you are going to a different university, you must request your transcript from PU to be sent to your college of choice using the following link

DUAL CREDIT THROUGH IVY TECH



- If you registered for dual credit courses offered through Ivy Tech –
 - And you are going to Ivy Tech, grades will be submitted to Ivy Tech at the end of the semester. Ivy Tech will process the grade and then the course and grade should be on your Ivy Tech transcript shortly after
 - If you are going to a different university, you must request your transcript from Ivy Tech to be sent to your college of choice using the following link
